DTaP

18-23 MONTHS:

Hepatitis A

4-6 YEARS:

DTaP, MMR, Polio, Varicella (Chickenpox)



Combination Vaccines

Comvax- combines Hib and Hep B

Kinrix- combines DTaP and IPV (polio)

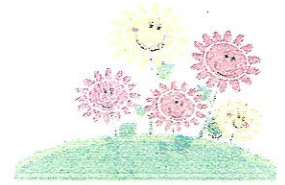
Pediarix- combines DTaP, Hep B, and IPV (polio)

Pentacel- combines DTaP, IPV (polio), and Hib

Prevnar 13- Pneumococcal 13 valent

ProQuad- combines MMR and varicella (chickenpox)

Twinrix- combines Hep A and Hep B



Vaccine Acronyms

DTaP-Diphtheria+ Tetanus+ Pertussis

RV 1 or 5 - Rotavirus

HepA- Hepatitis A

VAR-Varicella (Chickenpox)

HepB- Hepatitis B

Hib- Haemophilus influenzae -B

IPV- Inactivated Polio

MMR- Measles +Mumps +Rubella

OPV- Oral Polio

Influenza vaccine is recommended every year for everyone age 6 months and older. Some children younger than age 9 need 2 doses; ask your health care provider to determine if your child needs more than 1 dose.
